Conservation Innovation Grants (CIG) – NRCS

This is a competitive program that supports the development of new tools, approaches, practices, & technologies to further natural resource conservation on private lands. Through creative problem solving and innovation, CIG partners work to address our nation's water quality, air quality, soil health & wildlife habitat challenges, all while improving agricultural operations.

Projects can last up to 3 yrs. Project must start same year it is awarded. Multiple non-gov organizations can collaborate on project proposal but only one can be the applicant. There is a state & national level. National level projects support the early-stage development & piloting of new tools, practices & technologies to further natural resources conservation on private lands targeted towards national conservation priorities. State level projects do the same but are specific to state-identifies conservation priorities.
